3. When faced with life's challenges, why do people often call out for spiritual guidance?



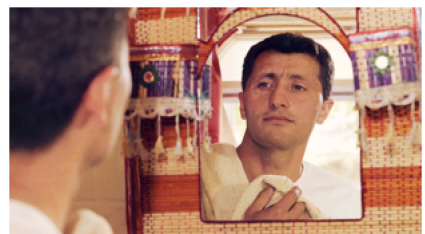
### **Let Empathy Flow**

3. How do you deal with sadness and loss? Do you face it or avoid it?



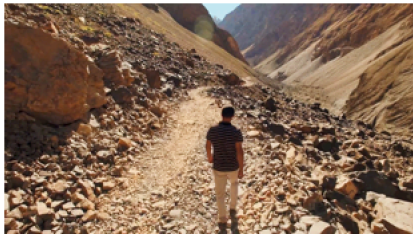
### **Strength in Meekness**
